Do you receive standard paper remittance (SPR) advices?

The majority of the providers in the First Coast Service Options Inc. (First Coast) jurisdiction submit their claims electronically. However, First Coast's records also show that for July 2015, 9 percent of all the Part B remittance advices were sent to providers as paper instead of an easy-to-use electronic format.

- Receive your remittances the day the claim finalizes
- Reduce costs associated with:
 - Storage and maintenance of SPRs
 - Staff time to review and file SPRs

The Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS) provides free software for you so that you can download, view, and print duplicate copies of Part A or B electronic remittances whenever you wish. If you currently submit your claims electronically and are not set up for electronic remittance, please complete the Electronic Data Interchange (EDI) Enrollment form found at http://medicare.fcso.com/EDI_forms/137486.pdf prior to downloading the free software.
