Patient Centered Medical Home Transformation Program

The Florida Department of Health Children's Medical Services (CMS) has partnered with HealthARCH on its statewide initiative to assist eligible pediatric and family medicine practices with Patient Centered Medical Home (PCMH) transformation.

PCMH Transformation

Eligible provider organizations will receive no-cost support through HealthARCH's Transformation support program. The program provides one-on-one technical assistance tailored to your organization.

Program Eligibility

If you are a Florida pediatrician or family medicine provider organization you are eligible to participate in the program.

PCMH Transformation



Purpose

The purpose of the Transformation Program is to assist Florida's pediatric and family medicine practices with adopting the PCMH model of care and become recognized through the National Committee for Quality Assurance (NCQA).

Requirements

The requirements for each participant are:

- 1. Enroll your organization in the program
- 2. Actively participate in minimum monthly technical assistance meetings
- 3. Designate a project lead for your organization
- 4. Make regular progress through the transformation process
- 5. Administer required patient experience survey
- 6. Remain an active PCMH upon NCQA recognition
